Response to a request for official information

Thank you for your request for official information received 23 March 2020 by Nelson Marlborough Health (NMH)¹, followed by the necessary extension of time 22 April 2020, where you seek information regarding the Royal College of Pathologists Australasia (RCPA) *Provision of second opinions with particular reference to morphological examination* policy for second and subsequent opinion of pathology specimens.

- 1. I respectfully request your DHB's policy on second opinions requested by a third party who is a medical practitioner currently involved in the medical care of the patient from whom the pathological material was originally obtained.***

DHB response

We are unable to provide you an opinion on this matter as Medlab South, Nelson Marlborough (part of the SCL Group) are the contracted service to NMH.

- 2. In the event that your DHB deviates from the aforementioned RCPA policy, I request an explanation for why your DHB deviates from best practice.***

DHB response

Medlab South, Nelson Marlborough which employs the pathologists that are contracted to the DHB, have their own processes which they follow relating to RCPA policy.
