## Response to a request for official information

Thank you for your request for official information as received 14 October 2020 by Nelson Marlborough Health (NMH)<sup>1</sup> where you ask about Ophthalmology referrals to Canterbury DHB.

1. I seek information on how many other people are like being refused care from the CDHB

<u>NMH response</u>: The introduction of the <u>Planned Care</u> pathway, traditionally known as 'Electives' and more than just hospital-based care and admissions, is a new direction toward our understanding of provision of person-centred care to those of higher priority first and in the most appropriate setting – we know that the way healthcare resources are arranged helps people to manage their healthcare needs and stay as healthy as possible.

Over 95%<sup>2</sup> of Ophthalmology referrals to CDHB Ophthalmology Services are accepted of which we believe promotes the effective care provided to individuals who are referred for such personal health services, and reflects the optimum arrangement for the most efficient delivery of these services to meet the Nelson Marlborough population needs.

We understand that the clinical enquiry in your letter dated 14 October 2020 has been responded directly by CDHB.
