WHAT WE DO

Occupational Therapists work with people who may have an illness or a disability, to help them take part in everyday activities of life. They take into account the person's physical, mental, emotional, cultural, social and spiritual needs.

They work with the person and their family or whanau to improve their abilities by learning or practicing skills, or by adapting their environment e.g. providing advice on equipment or recommending housing alterations.

At Nelson Marlborough DHB, Occupational Therapists help people with disabilities in a wide range of hospital and community based settings.

Occupational Therapists working within NMDHB are registered with the NZ Occupational Therapy Board and comply with the Health and Competency Assurance Act (HPCA).

SERVICES MAY INCLUDE

- * Assessment of daily living skills including showering, dressing, wheelchair/seating, and moving around the home.
- * Assessments of how a person thinks and processes information and ways of improving their abilities in order to complete tasks.
- * Rehabilitation programmes to maximise a person's independence at home and in the community.
- * Identifying the need for equipment. A Therapist will advise regarding the most appropriate equipment to meet client's needs. Therapists are able to apply for equipment for those who are eligible for Ministry of Health funding (through 'Enable NZ') for equipment, wheelchairs/seating, and housing modifications.
- * Assessment &Treatment for Burns and Scar Management (ACC and DHB funded).
- * Lymphoedema Management (Wairau Hospital).

REFERRALS

INPATIENT OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

Inpatient Occupational Therapy services accept referrals from the medical team and complete assessments for inpatients of all ages.

ADULT COMMUNITY SERVICES

Adult Community Services accept referrals for adults aged 16 years and over that reside in the Nelson Marlborough district.

COMMUNITY SERVICES

Community Services for those under 16 can be referred for a short-term need for our services e.g. Following an accident/surgery.

OUTPATIENT SERVICES

Outpatient services accept referrals for Assessment & Treatment for Burns & Scar Management for all ages.

Referrals to the Occupational Therapy Department can be made by registered medical practitioners, DHB approved needs assessment co-ordination services, health professionals, family/self. Referrals will be accepted if they meet the access criteria.
