




ICU bed occupancy (% of ICU beds occupied or number of occupied bed days and total number

Response:



For your information, Graphs One and Two depict bed utilisation across all three shifts as an indication of occupancy across our Nelson Hospital Intensive Coronary Care Unit (ICCU) and Wairau Hospital High Dependency Unit (HDU) 16 beds for the specified time-frame.
