Response to a request for official information

Thank you for your request for official information as transferred from the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet and received on 1 December 2022 by Nelson Marlborough Health (NMH)¹, where you seek the following information:

 The total cost of every set-up including contractors, security, workforce, hireage, purchases, administration, equipment, computer connections, stationery and any other expense associated with these checkpoints at all hospitals and any other facilities across the nation.

<u>NMH response</u>: The nature of the information requested means that we cannot determine which costs are specifically related to every 'set-up' and which are ongoing operational expenses. As the information is not available in a form that identifies set-up costs from other costs, we decline to respond under section 18(f) 'the information requested cannot be made available without substantial collation and research'.

This response has been provided under the Official Information Act 1982. You have the right to seek an investigation by the Ombudsman of this decision.
